### Ultraviolet light, ozone

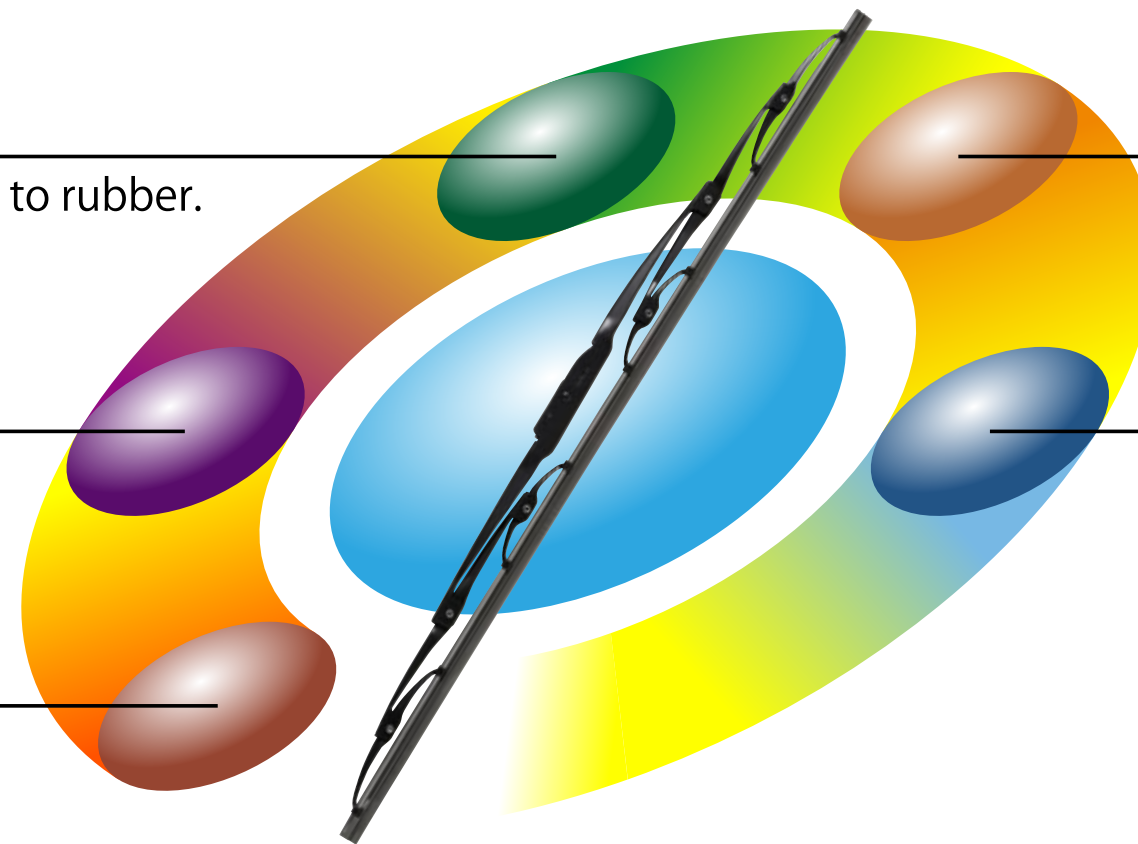
These are some of the major causes of damage to rubber.

### Oil

### Snow, ice
